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VNG INSTRUCTIONS

VNG testing is used to identify diseases or disorders causing vertigo, dizziness or inner ear disorders. You will be asked to put on special goggles that will measure nystagmus - an involuntary, repetitive movement of the eyeball. Several recordings of eye motion will be made while you move your head in different positions. The tests will be performed while small quantities of warm and cold water are placed in your ear canals. The VNG test takes approximately 30 minutes.

Please do not eat for three hours before a VNG test. **If you are diabetic, do not skip any meals.** Refrain from taking sedatives, tranquilizers, antihistamines, drugs for nausea or dizziness and alcoholic beverages for 24 hours prior to your appointment. If you are on any medications for heart, blood pressure, thyroid, cholesterol, diabetes or epilepsy, continue these as usual. **Please refrain from applying mascara or any makeup or moisturizer to your eyes or face.** Although rare, some patients experience prolonged dizziness after the test is complete, therefore is recommended that you have someone drive you home after the test if possible. **Please check in at least 10 minutes early.**
